

D. Andrew Stewart is a composer, pianist and digital musical instrumentalist. After developing his own sensor-suit in 2000, he began pursuing a career in live electronics – gesture-controlled – performance. Andrew Stewart's practise centres around two areas: combining acoustic instrument and digital instrument composition and performance; establishing repertoire and performance practises for digital instruments. Stewart is an innovator in these fields, especially with regards to his development of repertoire for the t-stick, on which he is the sole expert worldwide.
